**BY-LAW NO. 2024-06**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2023-27 Clean Yard  
& Properties By-Law**

WHEREAS By-Law No. 2023-03 was adopted by Council on 13<sup>th</sup> November 2023;

AND WHEREAS amendments are required;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF GORE BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Schedule B is amended as follows:

**PART I, *Provincial Offences Act***

6.	Leave property free from injurious insects, rodents, vermin, termites	2.1 e)	\$150
7.	Fail to store/keep inoperative/unlicensed vehicles/vehicles with visible current validation/boat/trailers/aircraft/mechanical equipment in a manner that might create fire/accident/health hazard/unsightly appearance	3.1 a)	\$450
8.	Store used vehicles for wrecking/dismantling/salvaging parts for sale/disposal	3.1 b)	\$450
9.	Store a vehicle/boat/trailer/recreational vehicle on an area not properly surfaced/covered	3 .1 d)	\$350
10.	Fail to maintain land free from domestic waste	4.1 a)	\$350
11.	Fail to maintain land free from industrial waste	4.1 b)	\$450
12.	Using any land or structure within the municipality for dumping or disposing of Domestic Waste or Industrial Waste.	4.1 c)	\$500
13.	Fail to maintain land free from standing water	5.1 a)	\$150
14.	Fail to remove and dispose of feces	7.1	\$150
15.	Hinder or obstruct an officer	9.1 c)	\$125

**Note: The penalty provision for the offences indicated above is section 9.1 of this By-Law No. 2023-27 of which a certified copy has been filed.**

2. THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the final date of passing hereof.
